



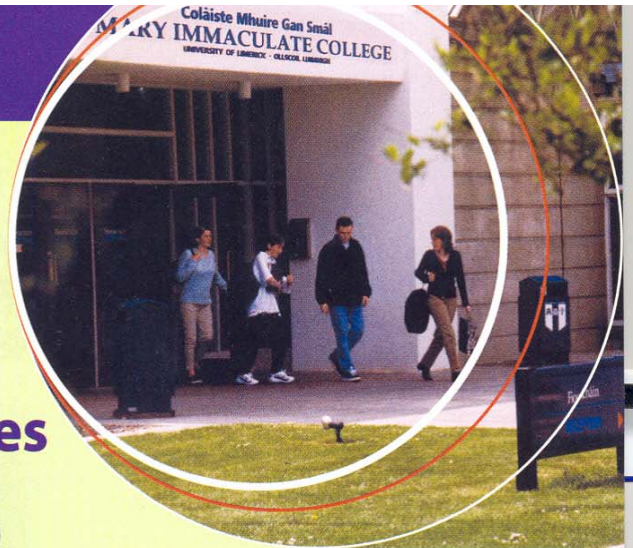

M.A. in Liturgical Studies

Aim of the programme:

- To provide participants who are involved in the area of liturgical preparation in the various religious traditions with an academic and professional qualification;
- To enable participants to incorporate the contribution of Liturgical Studies into their personal and working lives;
- To initiate participants into research in liturgical studies.

What the course offers:

- One-year full-time or two-year part-time programme that requires completion of six modules and a dissertation;
- A response to the increasing requirement for academic and professional training in liturgical Studies across all liturgical traditions.
- Modules that include the following:
History of Christian Liturgy
Sacramental Initiation,
The Forms of Celebration
Liturgical Theology,
The Eastern Liturgical Tradition,
Liturgy in Particular Liturgical Contexts.

Entry Requirements:

The normal requirement for entry to the MA in Liturgical Studies programme is a First or Second Class Honours primary degree in Theology OR Theology and Religious Studies OR a related academic discipline. Applicants with equivalent qualifications or substantial relevant experience may also be considered. Final selection will require attendance for interview. Applicants without a First or Second Class Honours primary degree may, with the approval of the Course Co-ordinator, pursue a qualifying programme and be examined on completion of that programme. The examination may be taken once only.
